This (CLP/Union Branch) notes that:

- Research from the End Child Poverty Coalition showed the two-child benefit cap is a key driver of child poverty.
- Save The Children estimate scrapping the cap could immediately lift as many as half a million children out of poverty
- The Child Poverty Action Group considers scrapping the two-child limit the most cost-effective way to reduce child poverty.

This (CLP/Trade Union Branch calls on the Government to:

- Restore the Labour Party whip to the 7 Labour MPs who voted to scrap the two-child benefit cap.
- Immediately begin work on legislation to scrap the two-child benefit cap.
